Manager of Landfill Operations (MOLO)

The Manager of Landfill Operations 3-day course includes all the latest landfill techniques and technologies to improve your knowledge of landfill operations.

In the course you will receive information and training in the following areas:

- Understand the scope of landfill importance, purpose, characteristics, design, equipment and compliance with regulations
- Manage daily operational procedures
- Improve landfill safety
- Understand construction and surveying practices
- Implement and manage effective monitoring systems
- Maximize your site's administration
- Improve efficiency and control costs

Use the course as a preparation for the SWANA MOLO Certification Exam or to just learn more about landfill operations and management. If you wish to become SWANA Certified, join us on the morning of June 9th to take the certification exam.

Please bring a calculator capable of handling seven digits for classroom activities and the exam.

Who Should Attend

This course is intended for landfill owners, operators, managers, supervisors, foremen, as well as engineers and employees responsible for daily landfill operation.

SWANA has over 8,000 members and a network of 48 Chapters in the US and Canada and has been offering Professional Certification for over 18 years. There are currently certification programs in 8 disciplines. A SWANA Certification is a nationally recognized program and many states, including Maine and New Hampshire, accept the certification and the required continuing education for their operator training and certification requirements.

Continuing Education

Completion of the courses will provide 30 hours of continuing education credits SWANA MOLO Certified Managers, Associates and Inspectors. 30 hours of continuing education credits are required every 3 years in order to maintain your certification through SWANA.
