Managing Transfer Station Systems

In the Managing Transfer Station Systems 3-day course you will receive information and training in the following areas:

- Fundamentals of Effective Planning, Design, and Operation of MSW Transfer Stations
 - Training on how to run facility in most effective way with hands-on tour, field exercise at a local transfer station and classroom exercises
- Learn about design objectives including capacity, selection of appropriate technology, structure considerations and site planning

Use the course as a preparation for the SWANA Transfer Station Certification Exam or to just learn more about transfer station system fundamentals and operation. If you wish to become SWANA Certified or if you have otherwise obtained your required continuing education units, and only need the exam, join us for the 4th morning to take the certification exam.

Please bring a calculator capable of handling seven digits for classroom activities and the exam.

Who Should Attend

Owners and operators of transfer stations, solid waste directors, and personnel managing on-site transfer system operations, and anyone preparing to become SWANA Transfer Station Certified

SWANA has over 8,000 members and a network of 44 Chapters in the US, Canada and the Caribbean and has been offering Professional Certification for over 18 years. There are currently certification programs in 8 disciplines. A SWANA Certification is a nationally recognized program and many states, including Maine and New Hampshire, accept the certification and the required continuing education for their transfer station operator training and certification requirements.

Continuing Education

Completion of the courses will provide 30 continuing education credits for SWANA Certified Transfer Station Managers, Associates and Inspectors and 10 credits for those certified in other disciplines.
