

**PRIVATE SECTOR DIRECTOR POSITIONS ON THE
SWANA INTERNATIONAL BOARD OF DIRECTORS
AVAILABLE BEGINNING IN FY 2012**

Seven Private Sector Members sit on the SWANA International Board of Directors (IB). These members represent different private sector views [finance, services, consulting, sales, manufacturing, legal and ad hoc], and help the Board maintain a balanced view on municipal solid waste management. These individuals are elected by all SWANA Sustaining Members. Terms of office are three years.

Three current Private Sector Directors will be completing their terms at the end of the Board meeting **in Nashville, Tennessee, August 2011: Constance Hornig, *Constance Hornig Law Offices*, [Legal Category], William DeBord, *Caterpillar-IL*, [Manufacturing Category] and R.B. “Bernie” Melcher, *Al-Jon, Mfg.*, [Sales Category].** Category descriptions are:

- **LEGAL** - should be employed as an attorney with a firm, or in private individual practice, that has a practice associated with municipal solid waste management and should be directly involved in municipal solid waste management legal matters.
- **MANUFACTURING** - should be employed in a company engaged in the manufacturing of products for municipal solid waste management and should be involved in the manufacturing side of the company.
- **SALES** - should be employed in a company engaged in the manufacturing of products and materials for municipal solid waste management or representing a company’s products and materials and should be directly involved in sales and promotion of products and materials.

Private Sector Members interested in being considered for one of these positions for a three year term (August 2011 through July 2014), should send their resumes (via email kcallaghan@swana.org or fax 240-645-1836) to Kathy Callaghan no later than April 1st, 2011. Members of the Board are expected to attend two Board meetings each year [one at WASTECON, and one mid-year at various sites in the US & CN], as well as serve on one of the four Board committees [Finance, Policy, Planning, Membership/Chapters].

All Private Sector Members in good-standing are eligible to vote, and election will be by ballot on-line.
